



### Directions to First Presbyterian

Take Interstate 95 North to exit 373. Then take A1A east to Fernandina Beach. Continue on A1A which becomes 8<sup>th</sup> street to Centre Street and turn left. The church is one block north on 6<sup>th</sup> street. Handicap parking is on 6<sup>th</sup> street. Signs will direct you to regular parking.

To get to Amelia Island you may also take U.S. 17 and intersect at A1A in the town of Yulee. If you are coming north on coastal A1A, take the ferry and rejoin A1A on the other side of the river.
