А	Moderator/ Vice Moderator	Learn the roles and responsibilities of the PW Moderator/Vice Moderator position at the congregation level. Presenter: Gayle Bone, PWP Moderator
В	Treasurer	Learn the roles and responsibilities of the PW Treasurer position at the congregation level.  Presenter: Wynetta Ussery, outgoing PWP Treasurer, and Lois Morse, incoming PWP Treasurer
С	Breast Cancer: Screening, Detection & and Prevention	This workshop will focus on the current screening recommendations, the importance of early detection, prevention strategies and risk reduction as well as time for questions.  Presenter: Dianne Johnson, M.D., a Diagnostic Radiologist specializing in breast imaging with Mori, Bean and Brooks Radiology, P.A.
D	Habitat for Humanity	Habitat for Humanity wants to empower women to help families build strength, stability and independence through the Women's Build program. 17,000 women volunteers were involved in building 1,000 homes in 2017 and it is never too late nor are you too old to help build. Get energized to volunteer to build by offering a hand-up, not a handout. Presenter: Martha Shafer, long time Habitat for Humanity volunteer.
