## <u>VITAL CONGREGATIONS INITIATIVE</u> Presbytery of St. Augustine

Vital Congregations Initiative (VCI) is a program of the PC(USA) Presbyterian Mission Agency.

PURPOSE of the Vital Congregations Initiative is to work alongside leaders of existing congregations continually assessing, discerning and living into faithful actions that increase vitality through intentional spiritual practices that take them deeper into following Jesus Christ, so that their own lives are changed, congregations are transformed and the mission of God spreads throughout particular communities and the world.



The Vital Congregations Initiative is built around *seven marks of vital congregations:* 

- 1. Lifelong Discipleship Formation vs. Complacent "Christian" piety
- 2. Intentional Authentic Evangelism vs. "Christian" Hypocrisy
- 3. Outward Incarnational Focus vs. Inward Institutional Survival
- 4. Empower Servant Leadership vs. the Pastor's job
- 5. Spirit-Inspired Worship vs. Self-gratifying worship
- 6. Caring Relationships vs. Any other Social Club; façades
- 7. Ecclesial Health vs. Unhealthy dysfunction
