

Youth and Childrens Ministry Director

Overview

The First Presbyterian Church of Ocala is seeking a part time employee (10-15 hours per week) to organize and direct the youth and children's ministries of the church. The primary role is to manage and lead programs that minister to young children and their families through education, activities, and counseling.

Responsibilities

- Lead or Coordinate activities and meals for the Middle and High School Youth group (combined meeting)
- Organize and execute outreach and mission events and activities for youth, children, and families.
- Lead or Coordinate Sunday Childrens activities (Childrens Message, Sunday School, and Nursery Volunteers)
- Lead and/or Coordinate Youth and Childrens activities (Holiday events, seasonal retreats/camps, etc.)
- Direct a 1-Week Vacation Bible School camp (1/2 day) each summer for children ages 3-10.
- Participate as a member of the Christian Education Committee (Meets monthly)

Essential Position Requirements

- Knowledge of and commitment to the mission and ministry of FPC Ocala as expressed through Our Mission and Matthew 25.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills; good listening skills
- Well-organized and able to manage multiple projects at one time
- Strong interpersonal skills, able to relate well with a diversity of people, including religious diversity
- Demonstrated skills in working in a team relationship

Other requirements

- Travel may be required (Youth retreats and Mission Trips)
- Requires the ability to work evening/weekend hours to support events/programs/travel
